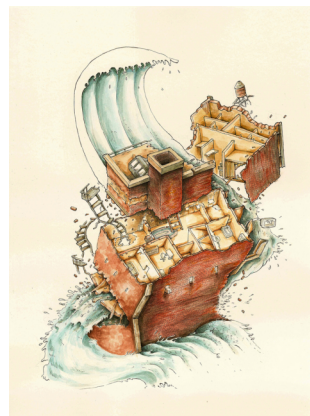
**A request for help:** With having the church open every Saturday from the beginning of May people are needed to be here. Please help - a list at the back of the church!
